Paving Work on Martin Luther King Jr. Avenue SE May 5 – May 14

(Washington, DC)—The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) will conduct paving work in the southbound and northbound lanes of Martin Luther King Jr. Avenue SE from Milwaukee Place SE to 4th Street SE beginning on Wednesday, May 5 to Friday, May 14 between the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., weather permitting. Parking lanes may be impacted while this work is taking place. No Parking signs will be posted 72 hours prior to the start of work. A travel lane will be maintained in both directions.

This paving work is part of the Revitalization of Martin Luther King Jr. Avenue SE Project (from Milwaukee Place SE to 4th Street SE).

Traffic controls, including signage, will be in place to guide motorists and pedestrians safely through the work zone. All users of the roadway are advised to stay alert and be observant of signage and work zones while traveling in this area.
